Dear Parent/Carer,

The First Minister has announced that the isolation period has been altered in relation to COVID-19. This affects not only all new isolations from Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> December, but also impacts on all staff, pupils and families currently isolating.

*From Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> December, people should self-isolate for 10 days if they:*

- *Received a positive test result for Covid-19*
- *Have symptoms of Covid-19 and are waiting for a test result, or have not been tested, but do not require hospital treatment*
- *Live with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 or is showing symptoms that may be caused by the virus*
- *Have any close contacts who have tested positive for coronavirus*
- *Are returning from a non-exempt country*

For our Year 10 students current isolating this will reduce the period by 4 days, with the last day of isolation being Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> December.

Please continue to check your email for any further important information that we will share over the next few days. We are aware that the school website is currently unavailable and are working on this as a priority. Further information will be emailed to families and added to the website and school app as it becomes available.
