Flexible return to education – Rhosnesni High School

Further to my letter dated 4th March, I am pleased to confirm that Rhosnesni students will return to school for on-site learning in the following way:

You will see that, as instructed by Welsh Government, Year 11 students are returning fully. Year 10 students will receive four full days on site, in recognition of their GCSE examination group status.

All other year groups will have two on-site teaching days before, I anticipate, a full return to school on Monday 12th April. When your child is not in school, they will continue to learn remotely from home.

All students will enter school at 8.40am from the Borrás Road entrance, as they did before the Christmas break. Students will also leave, from the Borrás gate, at the times that were communicated in September 2020. Again, I respectfully request that parents do not park, drop-off or collect near the school's entrances. Parents who do so are inadvertently endangering the lives of our students.

Unlike the autumn term, students are now required to wear face coverings in classrooms. Your support and understanding in this matter will be essential. As with social distancing, rigorous hand sanitising and respiratory hygiene, please reinforce the importance of wearing face masks when you are preparing your child to return to school site.

We look forward to welcoming students back to Rhosnesni grounds in a safe and manageable way. You will be contacted with further risk mitigation information and reminders in the coming days. Please ensure that your child returns in full school uniform.
