Uniform Guide and Information



At Ysgol Rhosnesni, school uniform is a vital aspect of the school's ethos and maintaining high standards. Specific uniform items such as blazers and ties are produced by main suppliers, however garments that can be purchased from a range of high street stores are more difficult to standardise. Some retail outlets market their products as school uniform, when actually this may not be the case. We urge parents/carers to ensure that they only purchase items intended to be used for school uniform which comply with our uniform policy.

We do not want to inform parents/carers in September that they have purchased clothing and/or footwear that will not be acceptable. If you have any questions/queries regarding any aspect of uniform, please contact your child's Progress Manager and they will address this for you.



Acceptable and Unacceptable Uniform

TROUSERS


- Plain black, regular cut, full length trousers (see image below).
- No denim, cord, stretchable, skin tight or other non-standard material.
- Trouser styles not permitted include: bootcut, flare, drainpipe, skinny, cargo, jeans, leggings, jeggings, chino and cropped calf length / ankle grazers.
- No studded or fashionable belts are permitted a plain black belt can be worn through trouser loops on the waistband.





SKIRTS

- A plain black 'A' line or pleated knee length skirt. See images below.
- No denim, cord, stretchable or other non-standard material.
- Tight fitting, pencil, tube-like skirts must **not** be worn.
- No splits in skirts
- Longer length skirts are available from Marks and Spencers and RAM Leisure






SHOES

- Plain black traditional formal style shoe.
- Leather/ leather style polishable shoes
- Strictly **no** boots or trainers permitted
- Can be slip on, 'velcro' straps or laced (eyes not hooks)
- No canvas, fabric, Vans, stiletto, high heeled open toe or sandal styles.
- No logos, labels, decorative metal buckles or chains.
- No suede shoes

SOCKS AND TIGHTS

- Only plain black socks must be worn
- No trainer style socks
- No knee high or over the knee socks
- Plain, opaque black tights only.
- No patterned tights or pop socks
