Dear Parent/Carer,

As we begin to move into a new phase and look ahead to the next academic year, I would like to outline our high expectations regarding school uniform from September 2021. At RHS, school uniform is a vital aspect of our school's ethos and high standards. When school returns after the summer break all students are expected to wear full school uniform correctly at all time without exception.

The two documents which accompany this letter include the School Uniform and Equipment Policy (attached) which clearly outlines our expectations in terms of appropriate trouser and skirt styles and lengths, socks and footwear. Items such as rings, necklaces, bracelets, false nails, facial piercing, extreme hairstyles and false eyelashes are not permitted. Earrings should be a single stud in each earlobe only.

The second document entitled the Uniform Guide and Leaflet for parents/carers (attached) should be read in conjunction with the policy. The purpose of this leaflet is to help assist parents/carers in making appropriate choices the first time. We do not want to inform parents/carers in September that they have purchased clothing and/or footwear that will not be acceptable.

We would ask our parents/carers to take time to look through the pictures in the leaflet, to clarify what constitutes the stated Rhosnesni High School uniform in terms of shoes, socks, trousers and skirts. Whilst this doesn't cover every possible style, hopefully it will be of help in providing a better idea of what is expected.

### **Purchasing School Uniform**

They are the only supplier of our school uniform logo items. The company is uniquely placed to be able to offer the purchase of good value, quality uniform and other essentials. Please ensure that you have read the school uniform guidance and policy before purchasing uniform items.
