Team Rhosnesni's commitment to improving students' attendance is of primary importance this year. We strongly believe that by working in partnership with parents and students we can continue to raise standards of attendance and punctuality.

Please ensure your child is on the school site by no later than 8.40am. Latecomers will be placed on detention using the following weekly cycle:

Students late on Friday, Monday or Tuesday will be placed on detention for 30 minutes on a Wednesday.

Students late on 2 or more of these days will be placed on detention for 1 hour on a Wednesday.

Students late on Wednesday or Thursday will be placed on detention for 30 minutes on a Friday.

Students late on both Wednesday and Thursday will be placed on detention for 1 hour on a Friday.
