Dear Parents, Carers and Students,

At Rhosnesni High School we are committed to reducing 'Period Poverty' in accordance with Welsh Government guidelines. Therefore, we have a range of free sanitary products available for our students.

Why is Period Poverty Important?

Research has demonstrated that many girls miss out on their education because of their period.

49% of female students across the UK have missed an entire day of school when they had their period. This leads to approximately 137,000 girls missing school each year.

10% of women aged 14-21 cannot afford to purchase sanitary products.

Therefore, we will be relaunching our "Red Box Campaign" to promote the supplies of free sanitary products for any student at our school. In case of an emergency, we have a stock of clean underwear available. Requests will be handled carefully and sensitively.
