Dear Parent / Carer

To reward and acknowledge your child's membership of the school's Welsh language student leadership team, the Welsh Department is organising a short, funded residential visit to Gwersyll Yr Urdd Glan Llyn, near Bala from **Wednesday, 20 April to Thursday 21 April 2022**. This activity will focus on enabling all participants to practise and develop their Welsh language skills whilst enjoying a range of activities within the naturally Welsh speaking environment of the Urdd Camp and surrounding area. The visit has been arranged as part of the school's focus on promoting bilingualism and enabling our students to effectively develop their skills in using the Welsh language beyond the classroom in preparation for future careers. During their stay, students will have the opportunity to take part in a range of workshops and activities and will be encouraged to use their Welsh throughout their stay.

The course has been scheduled to take place during the Easter holidays with a particular focus on the informal use of Cymraeg beyond the classroom. All participants will meet at the front entrance of the school at **9.30am** on the Wednesday morning to be registered before leaving the school with the accompanying members of staff at approximately 9.45am to travel by coach to Glan Llyn. Students will return to the school's main entrance by approximately **2.30pm** on the Thursday.

Parents will be required to ensure transportation for their child to and from the school at the start and end of the visit.

Students will be provided with an information list of the suitable required clothing and footwear once they have secured a place on the activity. As the accommodation and transport fees are fully funded, students need only bring pocket money for the light refreshments that they may wish to purchase through the medium of Welsh at the location.
