Dear Parent / Carer

To reward and acknowledge your child's excellent work ethic, effort and commitment in learning Welsh, the Welsh Department is organising a funded day trip to Gwersyll Yr Urdd Glan Llyn, near Bala on **Monday, 4 July 2022**. This activity will focus on enabling all participants to practise and develop their Welsh language skills whilst enjoying a range of outdoor activities and water sports within the naturally Welsh speaking environment of the Urdd camp. The visit has been arranged as part of the school's focus on promoting bilingualism and enabling our students to effectively develop their skills in using the Welsh language beyond the classroom in preparation for future careers. Participants will be provided with a phrase booklet and will be encouraged to use their Welsh throughout the day with Welsh speaking staff.

All participants will meet at the front entrance of the school at 8.00am on the day to be registered before leaving the school with the accompanying members of staff at approximately 8.15am to travel by coach to Glan Llyn. Students will return to the school's main entrance by approximately 5.15pm on the same day.

Parents will be required to ensure transportation for their child to and from the school at the start and end of the visit.

Students are not required to wear school uniform for this activity and are advised to wear old, comfortable clothes such as leggings or a tracksuit and an old pair of trainers. Students will be provided with a detailed list of additional required clothing and footwear nearer the time. As the visit is fully funded, students need only bring pocket money (maximum of £5.00) for the light refreshments that they may wish to purchase through the medium of Welsh at the location.

Students are required to bring a packed lunch, a morning snack and a bottle of water on the day. Students in receipt of free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch from the school canteen.

If you would like your child to take advantage of this opportunity, please complete the attached proforma and return it to school no later than **Monday, 23rd May 2022**. Due to the popularity of this activity and the Welsh Department's aim of rewarding students who demonstrate an exemplary attitude towards learning the Welsh language, students are selected for this activity on their work ethic and eagerness to become accomplished Welsh speakers.
