Safeguarding- Online Grooming

Who is talking to your child? Do you know?

North Wales Police have requested all Wrexham schools to contact parents/carers in order to reinforce the importance of regularly checking and monitoring their children's phones and social media accounts to help to keep their children safe. This follows very serious concerns regarding students being groomed on line and indecent images being distributed to and viewed by other children. Not only are they breaking the law by being in possession of an indecent video of a child and distributing it, they are also very vulnerable themselves to being groomed.

Online Grooming Prevention Campaign

The Welsh Government has teamed up with the Internet Watch Foundation (IWF) to launch a bilingual online grooming prevention campaign on Hwb. This is in response to an increase in children being groomed, deceived or extorted into sharing a sexual image or video of themselves. The campaign aims to empower children and young people to spot the signs of online grooming and exploitation, and to warn parents and carers about this threat, which can often occur in plain sight, on popular platforms and apps.

Police Cadets

North Wales Police are recruiting cadets. Students aged between 13yrs up to 15½ are welcome to apply. Cadets will get an insight into the police, through obtaining basic knowledge of police procedures and legislations. You will also receive inputs from various police departments such as the Drone, Firearms or Dog Units. You may get to visit areas which are off limits to the general public, such as Custody or Control Room. You will also attend events and assist the local neighbourhood teams in their duties. Lastly, Cadets is fun and there are various activity days throughout the calendar. The programme runs for 2 years, ending with the option to become a Senior Cadet or to become an Assistant Cadet Leader.
