LGBTQ+ History Month

February is LGBTQ+ History Month and this year's theme is #behindthelens and explores the LGBT+ community's contribution to film and cinema. LGBTQ+ History Month was created in 1994 and is celebrated in countries across the world as a chance to bring the often overlooked history of the LGBTQ+ community to light. In the UK, the month coincides with the abolition of Section 28 legislation that banned schools from discussing or 'promoting' anything to do with the LGBTQ+ community. Our school's LGBTQ+ Club is commemorating the month by creating a rainbow shaped mural that takes you on a journey through history; from the 1960s to the present day.
