Attendance

All parents/carers will receive an attendance report after Easter. It is essential that students attend school regularly and maintain a pattern of good attendance throughout their school career. Excellent attendance at school is important to allow a young person to fulfil their potential. You can demonstrate your commitment to your child's education by not taking holidays during term time. Any young person who is absent from school due to a holiday will miss out on important learning and will fall behind with their school work. In each school year there are only a maximum of 190 statutory school days – this allows plenty of time for holidays to be arranged outside term time. Holidays taken during term time will be categorised as unauthorised.

In the remaining days prior to the Easter holiday, we ask for your support to ensure your child attends school every day for the rest of this half term, when they are able to do so. This includes the final day of this term, which is Friday 31st March, closing at 3.00pm as usual. Students who regularly take the "odd day off" do not realise the long term effect this will have on their learning. Students do not need an extended holiday, they have a week to relax, socialise and recharge. Therefore, all students should attend school until the end of term unless absence is absolutely unavoidable. Thank you in anticipation of your support in this matter.

Students need to be on the school site by no later than 8.40am. Latecomers will be placed on detention and parents/carers will be informed as a matter of courtesy via a text message.
