A full day's absence will not be authorised unless there is a need to travel a significant distance.

At RHS our whole school target for attendance is 97%. It is our expectation that all students attend school every day unless there is a genuine reason for absence. Minor ailments should not prevent students from attending school. Thank you for your continued support.

In the remaining days prior to the May half term holiday, we ask for your support to ensure your child attends school every day for the rest of this half term, when they are able to do so.
