Attendance

All parents/carers will receive an attendance report this week. It is essential that students attend school regularly and maintain a pattern of good attendance throughout their school career. Excellent attendance at school is important to allow a young person to fulfil their potential. You can demonstrate your commitment to your child's education by not taking holidays during term time. Any young person who is absent from school due to a holiday will miss out on important learning and will fall behind with their school work. In each school year there are only a maximum of 190 statutory school days – this allows plenty of time for holidays to be arranged outside term time. Holidays taken during term time will be categorised as unauthorised.

A reminder that students need to be on the school site by no later than 8.40am. Latecomers will be placed on detention and parents/carers will be informed as a matter of courtesy via a text message.

Please ensure appointment letters are provided in order for medical absences to be authorised. It is the school's expectation that students should attend school before and following their appointment wherever possible. A full day's absence will not be authorised unless there is a need to travel a significant distance.
