- This meeting will provide an opportunity for parents to meet members of the Senior Leadership Team, Mrs Anderton-Schofield, Head of Year 7 and Transition Co-ordinator, and other key staff who work with Year 7 students.
- This is a meeting for parents only and pupils are not required to attend.

Listed below are some of the main points to help ensure your child has the most enjoyable experience:

- Students should arrive at the Borras Road Gate for 8:45 each morning.
- Students are expected to wear their primary school uniform.
- Students can bring a bottle of water to drink. No energy or fizzy drinks are permitted.

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- Throughout the day students will be involved in various activities and lessons which will
 give them the opportunity to meet our staff and start to familiarise themselves with our
 school ethos.
- Lunch will be available in the canteen **for all students** with the cost covered. Please indicate on the form whether you would like us to provide lunch for your child, or if your child is in receipt of Free School Meals. Alternatively, pupils may bring a packed lunch with them on the two transition days.

Please make arrangements for your children to be collected from Rhosnesni at 2.50pm each day. If you wish for your child to make their own way home, then you will need to confirm this on the above consent form link. If your child is unable to attend on either of the transition days, it is important that you let Mrs Anderton-Schofield know.

I trust that our programme of events will provide reassurance that we understand the importance of transition. It is essential that we begin positively, as your child embarks on the next, exciting part of their school journey.
