GCSEPod

We have recently invested in GCSEPod, an award-winning digital content and revision provider. Through GCSEPod, students have access to over 6,500 'Pods'; 3–5-minute videos designed to deliver knowledge in short bursts. GCSEPod makes learning and revision more manageable, and every Pod is mapped to an exam board. Students can download Pods to watch offline, compete Check and Challenge quizzes and complete assignments set by their teachers.

In addition to supporting our GCSE learners, teachers will also be using GCSEPod to set homework and revision tasks for students in Years 7-9.

How to access GCSEPod:

- 1) Go to www.gcsepod.com and click "Login" in the top right-hand corner
- 2) Click "New to GCSEPod? Get started"
- 3) Select "Student"
- 4) Enter your child's name, date of birth and the school name
- 5) Create a username, password, and a password hint to help them remember the password
