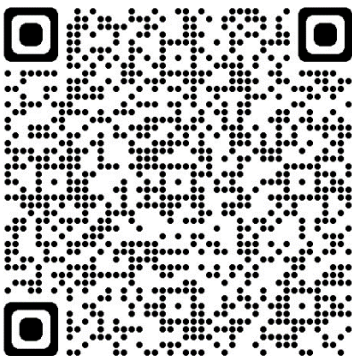
The school survey will focus on the following key areas :-
