The platform also includes a variety of learning activities, designed to help pupils commit this content to their long-term memory. The Check & Challenge tool provides quizzes for pupils to complete once they have watched a Pod. Check & Challenge provides scaffolded support through hints, multiple choice options and feedback statements to help consolidate learning and build confidence.
