Attendance

A reminder that students need to be on the school site by no later than 8.40am. Latecomers will be placed on detention and parents/carers will be informed as a matter of courtesy via a text message.

Please ensure appointment letters are provided in order for medical absences to be authorised. It is the school's expectation that students should attend school before and following their appointment wherever possible. A full day's absence will not be authorised unless there is a need to travel a significant distance.

At RHS our whole school target for attendance is 97%. It is our expectation that all students attend school every day unless there is a genuine reason for absence. Minor ailments should not prevent students from attending school. Thank you for your continued support.

In the remaining days prior to the May half term holiday, we ask for your support to ensure your child attends school every day for the rest of this half term, when they are able to do so. This includes the final day of this term, which is Friday 24th May, closing at 3.00pm as usual. Students who regularly take the "odd day off" do not realise the long term effect this will have on their learning. Students do not need an extended holiday, they have a week to relax, socialise and recharge.
