#### **Attendance**

We consistently promote excellent attendance, and aim to raise attainment and achievement levels by having high expectations of attendance for all our students. #### **Year 9 Induction Afternoon Coleg Cambria**

The induction afternoon for college courses will take place at Coleg Cambria Grove Park Campus or Bersham Road site (Engineering & Construction). The induction afternoon is from:

Students will be taken from school to the induction afternoon by bus, **but should make their own** arrangements to get home. Transport back to Coleg Cambria will be provided for students based at Bersham Road where they will need to make their own way home from here. Students who are taking performing arts, public services and sport courses should bring loose comfortable clothing with them.

The college have been informed if there is a clash with another course and they will sort it out from there.
