A rundown of both days is as follows:

Listed below are some of the main points to help ensure your child has the most enjoyable experience:

- Students should arrive at the Borras Road Gate for 9am each morning. Please be aware of the parking restrictions of this area and be mindful of our neighbours.
- Students are required to wear their primary school uniform.
- Students should bring a bottle of water to drink. No energy or fizzy drinks are permitted.

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- Throughout the day students will be involved in various activities and lessons which will give them the opportunity to meet our staff and start to familiarise themselves with our school ethos.
- Lunch will be available in the canteen for all students with the cost covered. Please indicate on the form whether you would like us to provide lunch for your child, or if your child is in receipt of Free School Meals. Alternatively, pupils may bring a packed lunch with them on the two transition days.

Please make arrangements for your child to be collected from the Borras Road Gate at Rhosnesni at 2.30pm each day. If you wish for your child to make their own way home, then you will need to confirm this on the consent form link. If your child is unable to attend on either of the transition days, it is important that you let Mrs Anderton-Schofield know in advance via the transition email address.

I trust that our programme of events will provide reassurance that we understand the importance of transition. It is essential that we begin positively, as your child embarks on the next exciting part of their school journey.
