Dear Parent/Carer,

As in previous years, I would like to stress our high expectations regarding school uniform for September. At RHS, uniform is a vital aspect of our school's ethos; it is something that underpins our commitment to high educational standards. When school returns after the summer break, all students will be expected to wear full school uniform correctly, at all times and without exception.

Our school uniform and equipment policy (attached) clearly outlines our expectations and should be read in conjunction with the uniform guide and information leaflet for parents/carers (attached).

The purpose of this information is to help assist parents/carers in making appropriate choices over the summer. We do not want to inform parents/carers, in September, that they have purchased clothing and/or footwear that will not be acceptable.

We ask our families to take the time to look through the pictures in the leaflet, to clarify what constitutes the approved Rhosnesni High School uniform in terms of shoes, socks, trousers and skirts. Whilst this doesn't cover every possible style, hopefully it will be of help in providing a better idea of what is expected.

Purchasing School Uniform

They are the only supplier of our school uniform logo items. The company is uniquely placed to be able to offer the purchase of good value, quality uniform and other essentials. Please ensure that you have read the school uniform guidance and policy before purchasing uniform items.

The Welsh Government funded School Essentials Grant is available to help towards the costs of a child's school uniform and equipment, for those on a low income.

If you have any concerns regarding uniform please contact your child's Head of Year for clarification.

Finally, I would like to take this opportunity to wish you and your family a safe and enjoyable summer. We look forward to seeing our students again when they return on Tuesday 3rd September.
