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#### Lockdown Procedures

This week, as part of our emergency planning processes, we will stage an important Lockdown Drill with staff and students. It will be done during Form Time and will cause very little disruption. Parents and students will be notified 24 hours in advance in order to avoid any surprise or concern.

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#### Attendance

At Rhosnesni High School we view attendance as a high priority for our students. Those who do not attend regularly often struggle to reach their potential. High attendance is also important for future employment, demonstrating a person's reliability. Furthermore, research has found that those students who have good attendance are less likely to become disaffected in education and rarely involve themselves in anti-social behaviour in the community. **Just 17 days absent from school a year could mean a drop in a GCSE grade in all subjects.**

Students need to be on the school site by no later than 8.40am. Latecomers will be placed on detention and parents/carers will be informed as a matter of courtesy via a text message.

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#### Uniform Standards and Conformity

Please can you ensure your child complies with the following key points in accordance with the uniform policy agreed by the Governing Body:

- Footwear - students must not wear canvass style pumps, boots or trainers. **Shoes must be polishable and a traditional style**
- Skirts - students must not wear denim, tight fitting, skin-tight, pencil, tube-like skirt. No splits. **Skirts must be knee length**
- Trousers - the following styles are not permitted: bootcut, flare, drainpipe, skinny, cargo, jeans, leggings, jeggings, chino and cropped calf length/ankle grazers.
- Socks - the following sock styles are not permitted: trainer style, knee high or over the knee socks
- No hoodies

- The following items are not permitted: false nails or eyelashes, facial piercings, necklaces, rings, bracelets or heavy makeup or nail varnish
- Earrings - only a single stud in each ear lobe is permitted on health and safety grounds
