Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to inform you that, from **Monday 27th April**, the PE department facilities will be unavailable as the sports hall and gym will be in use for GCSE examinations. Consequently, students will not have access to the changing rooms during this time.

While these arrangements are in place, pupils are expected to come to school in their **Rhosnesni PE kit on the days they have PE lessons** and will remain in their PE kit for the full school day, including all five lessons. Please ensure that your child is wearing the correct PE uniform, which includes:

- Rhosnesni t-shirt or polo shirt
- Rhosnesni zip-up top
- Plain black leggings or shorts
- White socks
- Appropriate trainers

Please note that colourful tops, cargo trousers, and shorts shorter than 5 inches are not permitted. Any pupil who arrives in incorrect PE kit will not be allowed to attend their usual lessons and will instead be required to sit in **On Call** until they have the appropriate sportswear.

Year 10 and Year 11 pupils who have GCSE examinations starting in May should come to school in full school uniform on the day(s) of their GCSE exams. If your child has a PE lesson on the same day as an exam, they will be able to participate by changing into their trainers. This will alleviate the issue of changing into full PE kit while the changing rooms are unavailable.

If a pupil is unable to participate in PE due to medical reasons, they should continue to attend school in their usual **Rhosnesni school uniform**.
