Listed below are some of the main points to help ensure your child has the most enjoyable experience:

- Students should arrive at the Borrass Road Gate for 9:00am each morning. Please be aware of the parking restrictions of this area and be mindful of our neighbours.
- Students are expected to wear their primary school uniform. Mobile phones are to be switched off and concealed in their bags when on school site.
- Students should bring a bottle of water to drink. No energy or fizzy drinks are permitted.
- Throughout the day students will be involved in various activities and lessons which will give them the opportunity to meet our staff and start to familiarise themselves with our school ethos.
- Lunch will be available in the canteen **for all students** with the cost covered. Please indicate on the form whether you would like us to provide lunch for your child or if your child will be bringing a packed lunch with them on the two transition days.

Please plan for your child to be collected from the Borrass Road Gate at Rhosnesni at 2.30pm each day. If you wish for your child to make their own way home, then you will need to confirm this on the above consent form link. If your child is unable to attend on either of the transition days, it is important that you let Mr Platt know in advance via the transition email address.
