School Ties

In readiness for the new school year, School ties are available from the school office they are now £4.00 and can be paid for through the ParentPay app.

Activities/ Tripday

A reminder that the school's Activities/Trip day is on Tuesday 14th July. Students who are not attending a trip should attend school as normal and will be following their normal timetable for the day.

School equipment

Please can you ensure that students come to school fully equipped as we enter the final week of term. Students will be taking books and school work home with them so will need to bring a bag to carry them home.

Peripatetic Music Lessons

There is the opportunity for students to receive Peripatetic Music lessons at Rhosnesni High School. Please see the attached poster. Any pupils who are interested are welcome to see Miss Rogers in the Music Department, who will be happy to help them get started.

The cost is £90 for a block of ten lessons. Pupils will also be provided with an instrument to take home for practice (excluding drums and piano).

For pupils who are eligible for FSM, there may be an opportunity to receive lessons free of charge. These places are limited, allocated on a first-come, first-served basis, and are subject to approval by the county.

Accessing and Leaving the School Site

In preparation for September's additional safeguarding procedures, from Monday 13th July, the Holt Road gate to our school field will only be open between 3:00pm and 3:10pm on school days. It will remain securely locked at all other times. All students must now arrive to school through the Borrass Road gate between 8:20am & 8:40am each day. This week will afford students and parents valuable time to adjust to new routines required for September '26. Arrangements for students with cycles, or those who arrive late, remain unaltered.

Mobile Phones, Smart Watches, Headphones and Electronic Devices

In the interests of Safeguarding, please could we remind you of our school rules with regards to Mobile Phones, Smart Watches, Headphones and Electronic Devices as outlined in the policy below. In the event you need to make contact with your child/children during the school day please contact the main school office on 01978 340840.

If a student brings their phone into school, we insist that the device is switched off and concealed safely in their bag whilst in the school grounds and buildings. Headphones must not be worn or be visible on the school site. Under no circumstances may mobile phones be visible, used or accessed by smart watches at break or lunchtimes. If mobile phones/headphones are seen/heard in school, staff will confiscate them from students to be collected at the end of the school day. Students who persistently fail to comply with this rule will receive further sanctions.

MCAS (My child at school) APP – Information Sharing

If you have not yet downloaded the MCAS app, please can you do so as a matter of priority. Moving forward this app will become the main source of communication between school and home. This will include communication regarding attendance, behaviour, exams, trips and school reports. Failure to download and sign up to the app, will result in you missing key information regarding your child/children's education.
